



NOTE: Your screen layout may look a little different depending on if you are setting up this software on a tablet (like this) or a phone.

1. You must download and install the Microsoft Remote Desktop app found (**it's free**) in the Google Play Store



2. Open the app
3. Click on **Remote Resources**



4. Enter <https://connect.jjc.edu/RDWeb> in the URL field


5. Enter your JJC email address (*username*@jjc.edu)
