Students are eligible for a third testing attempt within a semester only after completing ENG 020 (Reading) or ENG 098 (Writing) or successful completion of ACCUPLACER remediation through JJC's Tutoring and Learning Center. - To enroll in college-level English, you must place appropriately in Reading **AND** Writing.

ALEKS

- ALEKS scores are valid for **24 months**. There is a 24-hour waiting period between each test attempt. A mandatory minimum of 3 hours must be completed in the ALEKS Prep and Learning modules before attempts 3, 4, and 5.
- Math courses with an (*) also require the geometry prerequisite.
- The ALEKS test will provide an on-screen calculator when appropriate. Use of calculators not provided by ALEKS is prohibited.
