Nomination papers filed by a candidate should include:

- 1. Statement of Candidacy
- 2. Petition for Nomination
 - Candidates name for placement on the ballot will be taken from the top of the first page of nominating petitions.
 - No title (e.g., Dr.) before a name should appear on the petition.
 - A minimum of 50 valid signatures are required on the nominating petition pages.
 - Nominating petitions are to be properly notarized.
- 3. Receipt for filing of Statement of Economic Interests
 - The statement is required by the Governmental Ethics Act <u>and is to be filed with the</u> Will County Clerk.
 - The receipt for filing a Statement of Economic Interests must be for the office in which the candidate is running and filed with the local election official prior to the filing deadline of November 18, 2024.
- 4. Loyalty Oath optional
