Graduates of the program are eligible to sit for the radiography examination administered by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT). In addition to passing the examination of the ARRT, graduates must also follow guidelines of the state in which they intend to practice. In Illinois, for example, radiographers must show proof of ARRT registry and apply for state licensure.
