Prior to taking either, students should consult with their transfer institution to confirm transfer equivalencies since those can vary between institutions.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Depending on the number of credits for the math course. The total number of credits required for the IAI electives is 27, one of which may come from an extra credit from the math category if Math-128 is taken.
