## Associates in Arts - Kinesiology (Physical Education, Personal Training, Sports Mgmt.)

ICCB Approved Total Program Hours: 64 Semester Hours

The following suggested schedule is based on full-time enrollment for students who do not require any 0-level coursework. This Completion Guide is for students interested in pursuing a major in Kinesiology as part of a baccalaureate degree leading to careers in Physical Education, Personal Trainer, and/or Sports Management. Students should check with their transfer institution for specific requirements for their major. Requirements can vary between transfer institutions.

Students who complete the Associate in Science may be required to take an additional Social Science and Humanities/Fine Arts course at the transfer institution since they will not be completing the entire General Education Core Curriculum (GECC) prior to transfer. Students could choose to complete an Associate in Arts to transfer and then will have completed the GECC.
