* Students who wish to pursue a baccalaureate degree with more of a rhetoric and/or technical writing focus may opt to take Eng-230 as an approved elective for the AA degree. However, it has a pre-req of Eng-130 which is NOT an approved elective and will NOT count as part of the degree total for the AA degree. Please be advised, students who use Financial Aid of any

type may need to pay personally for Eng-130 since it is not an approved AA degree elective. Prior to taking either, students should consult with their transfer institution to confirm transfer equivalencies since those can vary between institutions.

** Depending on the number of credits for the math course. The total number of credits required for the IAI electives is 27, one of which may come from an extra credit from the math category if Math-128 is taken.

Graduation Requirements

To be awarded an Associate degree at Joliet Junior College, each student must meet the following requirements:

1. Satisfy all admissions requirements.
2. Complete the courses required to earn the given degree. If the student is a transfer student with coursework taken elsewhere, he/she must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours of which 15 credit hours applicable to the degree are earned at JJC. Proficiency test, CLEP, and Advanced Placement does not meet this requirement.
3. Earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0.
4. Discharge all financial obligations to the College and have no restrictions.
5. File an application for graduation. An application should be filed at the time of registration for the student's anticipated last semester.
6. Have all official transcripts from other college/universities on file in the Graduation Office by the graduation filing date for evaluation of credit. A delay in the process may result in a later graduation date.
