- \* Students are strongly encouraged to take MUS 104 the summer before their first fall semester at JJC in order to begin the music theory sequence. This 3-credit course applies to the IAI elective column total.
- \*\* Students should consult with potential transfer institutions right away upon beginning at JJC to know the transfer requirements for their specific music major and preferred timing of transfer. Some transfer schools may recommend transfer after one year at the community college. It's crucial that students meet with the JJC Music Faculty Advisor for assistance planning their JJC semesters with input from the transfer institutions. If additional coursework is recommended by the transfer institution related to NASM Certification, students should be advised that there could be financial aid eligibility limitations for coursework that exceeds the 64 credits of the Associate in Arts degree or exceeds a certain category within the degree. If that's the case, students should consider applying for scholarships and/or utilizing a personal payment plan option if need be.
- \*\*\* Depending on the number of credits for the math course. The total number of credits required for the IAI electives is 27, one of which may come from an extra credit from the math category if Math-128 is taken.

## **Graduation Requirements**

To be awarded an Associate degree at Joliet Junior College, each student must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Satisfy all admissions requirements.
- 2. Complete the courses required to earn the given degree. If the student is a transfer student with coursework taken elsewhere, he/she must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours of which 15 credit hours applicable to the degree are earned at JJC.

Proficiency test, CLEP, and Advanced Placement does not meet this requirement.

- 3. Earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0.
- 4. Discharge all financial obligations to the College and have no restrictions.
- 5. File an application for graduation. An application should be filed at the time of registration for the student's anticipated last semester.

6. Have all official transcripts from other college/universities on file in the Graduation Office by the graduation filing date for evaluation of credit. A delay in the process may result in a later graduation date.
