# BOOTCAMP 2023 COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN FRANCE

## NANCY - THE NEXT SMART CITY

JUNE 11TH - JUNE 25TH 2023, NANCY, FRANCE

This two-week summer program in Lorraine, France, will see participants tackling sustainable development with the aim of transforming the city of Nancy into a smart city of the future. Based in Nancy at our very own fab lab, the "Charly Lab", students will work in teams to design a virtual reality experience accessible on smartphones, tablets, computers or VR headsets. Through various excursions, students will discover the history and culture of the Lorraine region, as well as the many innovative projects led by the Université de Lorraine and local entrepreneurs. A two-day tour of Paris will round off the stay.



#### **VISITS AND ACTIVITIES**

Participants will discover Lorraine, from the region's two main cities, Nancy and Metz, to the surrounding areas. Highlights include a culinary tour of Nancy, the capital of Lorraine, an evening downtown at the Fête de la Musique, a visit to the Pompidou Center in Metz, a tour of some local vineyards and a trip to the beautiful Vosges mountains, including an afternoon at a treetop adventure park. And no trip to France would be complete without a tour of the world-famous sites of Paris: la Tour Eiffel, Arc de Triomphe, Musée du Louvre...

#### **LEARNING OUTCOMES**

- Students will complete the program with an understanding of the environmental issues facing cities and the steps implemented to improve their carbon footprint.
- Students will understand concepts such as eco-responsibility and additive manufacturing.
- Students will be introduced to virtual reality and 3D printing technologies.
- Students will be able to create a virtual tour of a city neighborhood.

- Nancy: City center studio apartments with private bathroom, bedding, WIFI and breakfast included. All meals included.
- Paris: Youth hostel accommodation near main station. Meals included.
