Costs

The cost for the program is \$2,400 plus airfare. The costs include furnished apartments, breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily, cultural visits, city and park tours, twenty-seven class hours, local transportation, and transportation to and from the airport.

- ·Identify a company's stakeholders' issues and make relevant recommendations.
- ·Use course concepts like the SHIFT framework, environmental boundaries, and circular economy in proposing a sustainable product or service.
- ·Identify sustainable business practices in France and Brittany while experiencing history and culture.
- ·Sharpen their problem solving, presentation, and cross-cultural communication skills and apply them to sustainable business.
