

NEW STUDENT STEPS

Apply to Jonet Junior Conege.	
 Submit your application at jjc.edu/admissions. Your MyJJC account is created 24-72 hours after applying. Look up your MyJJC username, ID number and create your password at jjc.edu/password. 	
☐ Submit your high school transcript or equivalency record.	
 Contact your high school to have your transcript or equivalency (GED, HiSET or TASC) sent to the JJC Admissions Office or e-mail admissions@jjc.edu. If you are still in high school, a current copy of your transcript will be accepted until your official transcript is available. These must be on file for appropriate math and science placement.
