# **Admitted Student Steps**

	MyJJC is where students view information that pertains to them including class schedule, important dates & deadlines and so much more. <b>Your account is created 24-72 hours after applying to JJC.</b>	
	Do you have a username & password for MyJJC? If not, then look up your MyJJC <u>username</u> and create your MyJJC <u>password</u> .	
	Complete the New Student Presentation located in MyJJC (requires MyJJC username and password) so you can learn how to become a successful JJC student.	
	Do we have your most current official high school transcript or equivalency record (GED, HiSET, or TASC)? If not, please contact your high school and have transcripts sent to the <u>Admissions Office</u> (1215 Houbolt Rd, Joliet IL, 60431 or <u>admissions@jjc.edu</u> ). If you are still in high school, a current copy of your transcript will be accepted.	
	* These must be on file for appropriate math and science placement.	
	Did you earn credit from another college or university? If so, be sure to submit official college transcripts to the <u>Registrar's Office</u> and complete a <u>Transfer Credit Evaluation Form</u> .	
	Have you completed placement testing and/or submitted your eligible scores to the Admissions Office? <u>ACT</u> and <u>SAT</u> scores must be submitted directly from the testing company. Visit <u>Testing Services</u> for additional information regarding JJC placement exams and <u>eligible scores</u> .	
	Now that you are admitted, how will you pay for your classes? Be sure to review <u>Cost</u> and Payment Options. Also, consider applying for <u>Financial Aid</u> and <u>Scholarships</u> .	
	Log into MyJJC to complete your remaining steps. Remember to complete the New Student Presentation and sign up for an Advising Session (requires MyJJC username and password)! Here you will meet with an Advisor <b>to plan and register</b> for your first semester schedule.

# Spring Classes (January)

- Application available: Sept. 1, 2019 to March 31, 2020
- Complete the New Student Presentation (online): September to November
- Placement Testing or submit appropriate scores: September to November
- Sign-up for Advising Session: September to November
- Registration for spring semester begins Oct. 21, 2019
- Financial aid priority deadline: Nov. 20, 2019
- Tuition due: Dec. 4, 2019 by 6 p.m. (tentative)
- Spring semester starts: Jan. 13, 2020

### **Summer Classes (May)**

- Application available: Oct. 1, 2019 to July 31, 2020
- Complete the New Student Presentation (online): October to February
- Placement Testing or submit appropriate scores: October to February
- Sign-up for an Advising Session: February to May
- Registration for summer sessions begins March 16, 2020
- Financial aid priority deadline: April 22, 2020
- Tuition due: May 6, 2020 by 6 p.m. (tentative)
- Summer session I starts: May 18, 2020
- Summer session II starts: June 1, 2020
- Summer session III starts: June 29, 2020

# Fall Classes (August 2020)

- Application available: Oct. 1, 2019 to Oct. 31, 2020
- Complete the New Student Presentation (online): January to April
- Placement Testing or submit appropriate scores: January to April
- Sign-up for an advising session: April to July
- Registration for fall semester begins April 27, 2020
- Financial aid priority deadline: June 24, 2020
- Tuition due: July 8, 2020 by 6 p.m. (tentative)
- Fall semester starts: Aug. 17, 2020
