1.5 Review of January 31, 2024 Workshop Minutes

2.1 Opening Remarks

Dr. Namuo thanked the board for their service. He said that the FY26 budget is future focused and student centered. He said the administration is committed to presenting a balanced budget and is committed to being responsible stewards of public funds.

2.2 Preliminary Budget Outlook

Dr. Namuo introduced Jeff Heap, Sr. Director Financial Services and Controller, who reported FY25 credit hours are trending over budget as well as property taxes are expected to be slightly over budget and interest revenue is expected to be 1 million over budget. Adjunct and faculty overloads and contractual, supplies, utilities and travel are all trending under budget. Revenue projections indicate an enrollment growth of 1.5% and an increase in new property taxes of 1.1%. Interest income earnings are projected at \$4.0 million. Expense projections for FY26 indicated a 7% increase in health care with a 3% increase in materials, supplies & contractual services. Utilities are projected to increase 4%. Budget projections of revenue is \$121,679,219 and expenses are \$120,915,415
