10.01.05 **INCIDENT RESPONSE**

Joliet Junior College (College) shall develop a formal set of procedures that allows the College to effectively and efficiently respond to an incident involving the identification of an information security compromise.

The College shall maintain an Information Security Incident Response Team (ISIRT) in accordance with industry standards that will be the initial responders to a reported information security incident on campus.

Any information security incident that results in the possibility of a breach of confidential information shall be reported immediately to the Information Security Officer (ISO). The ISO shall report to the Senior Leadership Team for review to determine further action including but not limited to disciplinary action, policy analysis, and/or public disclosure of information compromised.

**Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery**

An information security program needs to support the maintenance and potential restoration of operations through both minor and catastrophic disruptions. The College must ensure that its critical information assets can, in the case of a catastrophic event, continue to operate and be appropriately accessible to users. The College must maintain an ongoing program that ensures the continuity of essential functions and operations following a catastrophic event based upon a business impact analysis.
