12.05.00    EXPOSURE CONTROL PLAN

Joliet Junior College, Illinois Community College District 525, is committed to providing a safe and healthful work environment for our entire staff. In pursuit of this endeavor, a policy for Exposure Control Plan (ECP) is provided to eliminate or minimize occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens in accordance with the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard, Title 29 Code of Federal Regulations 1910.1030 and 56 Ill. Adm. Code 350.

The ECP is a key document to assist the College district in implementing and ensuring compliance with the standard, thereby protecting JJC employees. This ECP includes:

- A. Employee exposure determination;
- B. The procedures for evaluating the circumstances surrounding an exposure incident; and
- C. The schedule and method for implementing the specific sections of the standard, including:
  - Methods of compliance
  - Hepatitis B vaccination and post-exposure follow-up
  - Training and communication of hazards to employees
  - Recordkeeping
