01.61.00 PRESIDENT SUCCESSION

Reviewed:

The Board of Trustees (Board) delegates authority to the College President to appoint an acting President, subject to approval of the Board, to serve in their absence for short periods of time, not to exceed 30 consecutive calendar days.

If an emergency occurs when the President is away from campus and an acting President is not in place, the vice president in whose department the emergency is originating shall have primary responsibility for handling that emergency. The vice president shall communicate emergency issues with the President and with the Chair Person of the Board, as appropriate.

The Board may appoint an acting President for periods exceeding 30 calendar days, with input from the President when appropriate.
