01.70.00 <u>ICCB STATEMENT OF MISSION</u>

In recognition of the Illinois Community College Board's (ICCB) important role in the establishment of standards and criteria for Illinois community colleges, the Board of Trustees of Illinois Community College District No. 525 fully supports the mission statement adopted by the ICCB in July of 1981:

- to administer the Illinois Community College Act [110 ILCS 805/] in a manner that maximizes the ability of the community colleges to serve their communities,
- to promote cooperation within the system and accommodate those state of Illinois initiatives that are appropriate for community colleges,
- to be accountable to the students, employers, lawmakers, and taxpayers of Illinois, and
- to provide high-quality, accessible, cost-effective educational opportunities for the individuals and communities they serve.

The Board will seek an ICCB advisory opinion regarding the interpretation of the Act, as needed.
