Joliet Junior College (College), Illinois Community College District 525, is committed to providing a safe and healthful work environment for our entire staff. In pursuit of this endeavor, a policy for Exposure Control Plan (ECP) is provided to eliminate or minimize occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens in accordance with the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard [29 CFR 1910.1030] and Title 56, Part 350, of the Illinois Administrative Code.

The ECP is a key document to assist the College in implementing and ensuring compliance with the standard, thereby protecting College employees. This ECP includes:

- A. Employee exposure determination;
- B. The procedures for evaluating the circumstances surrounding an exposure incident; and
- C. The schedule and method for implementing the specific sections of the standard, including:
 - Methods of compliance
 - Hepatitis B vaccination and post-exposure follow-up
 - Training and communication of hazards to employees
 - Recordkeeping
