04.25.00 USE OF HUMAN SUBJECTS IN RESEARCH PROJECTS

It is the policy of Joliet Junior College (College) to comply with all applicable Federal regulations regarding the use of human subjects in research projects; to respect the rights, well-being and personal privacy of individuals; to assure a favorable climate for the conduct of academic-oriented inquiry; and to protect the interests of JJC.

JJC has implemented an Institutional Review Board in order to ensure that all data derived from human subjects associated with JJC is collected, used, and shared in a fashion that complies with the Code of Federal Regulations (45 CFR 46).

All researchers must follow the policies outlined in the College’s Institutional Research Board Manual when they are conducting research that involves human subjects affiliated with Joliet Junior College, regardless of whether the research is internally or externally funded. It applies to such research-related projects as student surveys, faculty projects, independent study projects, honors projects, and all other research with human subjects.
