



11.08.01 USE OF UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAVS) OR DRONES

Joliet Junior College (College) recognizes that Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs) or drones are a technology with the potential for use in multiple areas that would benefit the College and its students. Those areas include but are not limited to educational purposes, law enforcement and maintenance of facilities.

The use of UAVs brings with it various issues including state, federal and local legal compliance issues, as well as liability issues on the part of the College.

Operation of UAVs on College property, that are not owned by the College or operated on behalf of the College, is not permitted without specific authorization as laid out in Institutional Procedure 11.08.01.00 Use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles or Drones.

It is the policy of the College that all UAVs operated on College property shall be:

- A. registered as required by local, state and federal legislation;
- B. registered with the College;
- C. appropriately insured, and
- D. operated safely and in compliance with all state, federal and local legislation as well as all College policies and procedures (including Institutional Procedure 11.08.01.00 Use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles or Drones).
