03.03.01 TUITION AND FEES

The Board of Trustees (Board) will establish the tuition rate for students of the College. Out-of-district students shall not be required to pay higher tuition than that required for in-district students, provided these students comply with existing junior college laws relative to Comprehensive Agreement Regarding the Expansion of Educational Resources (CAREER Agreement) to sending districts. The Board shall also approve the establishment of any mandatory fees, including but not limited to an activity fee for the support of the student activity program, a technology fee, and the fee schedule for those courses with special laboratory requirements. In establishing the activity fee and serving as a collection agent for the activity program, the Board has assumed responsibility for the administration of said program as part of the general College budget. The final legal responsibility cannot be abdicated, and the administration is directed to administer the program in a manner designed to provide a balanced quality program for the student body and community that will be representative of the best in cultural arts, publications, athletics and other activities within the budgetary limitations established.
