01.51.00 REQUESTS FOR PUBLIC INFORMATION AND INSPECTION OF COLLEGE RECORDS

It is the public policy of Joliet Junior College (College) to comply with the terms and provisions of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)[5 ILCS 140/1] (referred to as Act). The College strongly supports the Act and its goal of transparency and accountability in government.

To ensure information is available to all members of the general public, the College has designated a FOIA officer. All FOIA requests will be processed in a timely manner, reporting to the President’s Office. In accordance with the Act, requests are to be submitted in writing by email, mail, fax, personal delivery or other available means.

The College shall follow all regulations specified in the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) related to furnishing records in electronic format or the format specified by the requester where feasible, and related to the charges permissible under state statute.
