03.05.01 SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

The Board of Trustees invites interested individuals, businesses and organizations to establish scholarships for the benefit of students. The stipulation requirement of each scholarship must be in writing in a signed Memorandum of Agreement between the donor and the institution through the Joliet Junior College Foundation.

Scholarship monies from private sources that are to be awarded as scholarships to JJC students are to be placed in the Joliet Junior College Foundation and will be administered in conjunction with the Financial Aid Office. Funds from governmental sources will be processed and administered under the direction of the director of financial aid or their designee.
