01.85.00 **BUILDING AND LOCATION IDENTIFICATION**

The Board, in consultation with the President and their staff, shall designate names for the College’s campuses, centers and buildings as the need arises.

In order to be consistent with state, federal, and accreditation guidelines that dictate the naming of College locations, the College will utilize three types of naming conventions for College locations: campus, education center, and satellite.

Campus. A “campus” is an organized administrative unit of the College that has a continuing educational mission and serves as a primary instructional site for the College. These campuses are designated as such in alignment with the Illinois Community College Board System Rules [Section 1501.301, Definition of Terms]. Those campuses below marked with an asterisk are designated “additional locations” for the Higher Learning Commission.

College campuses are:

- Joliet Junior College Main Campus
- Joliet Junior College Romeoville Campus *
- Joliet Junior College City Center Campus*

Education Center. An “education center” is an instructional site for the College that is used for offering some of the college’s courses and/or programs for a limited duration. These education centers are also referred to as “extension centers” by the Illinois Community College Board System Rules [Section 1501.301, Definition of Terms].

College education centers are:

- Joliet Junior College Frankfort Education Center
- Joliet Junior College Morris Education Center
- Joliet Junior College Weitendorf Agricultural Education Center

Satellite. A satellite refers to a location within the district that is a reasonable and moderate extension of the College. All other locations will be referred to as satellites.
