ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR AWARDING CREDIT

Joliet Junior College (JJC) recognizes the valuable experiential and classroom-based learning opportunities which exist outside the College structure. It is appropriate to offer opportunities for individuals to obtain College credit for individualized instruction, business and/or other agency-based training, as well as life experiences, applicable toward degrees and certificates awarded by JJC. In all cases of alternative methods for awarding credit (except for independent study) credit awarded is limited to active courses and students will have to meet the credit hour residency number required for the degree and/or certificate to which the credits are applied. Procedures for awarding alternative credit must be reviewed by the Academic Standards Committee.
