JJC Student ID

The JJC Student ID is an important part of your JJC experience.

- On-campus, it is the preferred form of ID at the Bookstore, Financial Aid, the Testing Center and it's your library card.
- Off-campus, you will need it to check out items from <u>JJC library</u> or to request an interlibrary loan. The <u>bookstore</u> will also confirm that you have received a JJC Student ID when using financial aid to purchase your books.

** If you are enrolled in a minimum of one class and you do not have a JJC Student ID yet you can request one using our online application.**

On the application, be sure to attach a picture of yourself against a <u>white background</u> (head and shoulders only!) and a picture of your government-issued ID (examples include driver's license, state ID, military card, passport, etc.) for verification purposes.

PREFERRED NAME

Joliet Junior College (JJC) works to ensure that all students have the opportunity to learn in a safe and supportive environment. JJC acknowledges that many students use first names other than their legal first name to identify themselves.

To request to have your preferred name used you will need to complete this form and arrange a meeting with the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities.

You can fill the form out online and save it to your desktop, then email it to Jonathon Feit and request an online meeting.

After your preferred name has been approved, please contact the Photo ID office to have a corrected copy of your student ID printed at no cost and mailed to you.

*This form will enable students to use a preferred name in the course of College business. This request allows students to identify the use of a preferred first name in addition to their legal name and will not facilitate the name change on any legal documents. Please note: The JJC Dean of Students will support the student's request whenever possible. It is also suggested that the student take a proactive role in this process and encourages communication with faculty members.

Online Learning (iCampus)

JJC's online classes take place on the platform iCampus, powered by Canvas. This state-of-the-art virtual classroom technology allows students to:

Username and Password

- Your JJC username allows you to access your JJC email, eResources, and iCampus/Canvas.
- Student usernames are created 24 to 72 business hours after <u>applying to JJC</u>.
- Student usernames expire after 365 days of inactive registration.
- Go to Find My JJC Username/ID to lookup your username.

Your account is created 24 to 72 business hours after applying to JJC. To begin using your account, you must set your password.

- Accounts are locked after 3 unsuccessful login attempts.
