- Taking a medical history
- Conducting EKGs
- Providing emotional support
- Monitoring patient conditions
- Helping patients with daily living and self-care activities
- Collecting blood and urine samples
- Performing and managing simple wound care tasks
- Transporting patients for diagnostic testing
