## Legacy Program Guidelines for **Spring 2025** Eligibility

The Joliet Junior College Legacy Program is awarded to the child, step child, or legal dependent of a JJC alumnus/alumna based on the following criteria:

- Applicant must be the child, stepchild, or legal dependent of a JJC alumnus/alumna.
- The alumni/alumnae has received an Associate's Degree or certificate from JJC.
- Applicant must be enrolled full-time at JJC (12 or more credit hours) in Spring 2025 semester.
- Applicant must be a resident of JJC's district.
- Applicant must be pursuing an Associate's Degree or certificate from JJC.
- Applicant must not have already earned a degree from JJC.
- **Incoming Freshman Applicants**: must be a 2024 High School graduate, have earned a minimum 2.5 cumulative HS GPA, and provide official HS transcript to the JJC Admissions Office.
- **Continuing JJC Student Applicants**: must have been enrolled full-time at JJC (12 or more credits) in Fall 2024 semester and have earned a minimum 2.5 GPA during that semester.

Failure to meet any of the above criteria will result in disqualification for Legacy funding.

Recipients will receive \$300 per semester, for a maximum of four semesters, to be applied to tuition and mandatory fees only.

If the amount of the Legacy Program award will in any way jeopardize other financial aid a student is about to receive, the award package will be adjusted.

NOTE: Students who are receiving the JJC Employee/Dependent tuition waiver program are not eligible for both programs during the same semester.

## **Applicants:**

- Legacy Program funding is only available for fall and spring semesters (not summer).
- Program funds are available for the first 100 eligible applicants per semester.
- Proof of parent (alumni) child (applicant) relationship required with initial application. This includes a copy of applicant's birth certificate, copy of parent marriage license (if alumni is stepparent), or legal guardianship paperwork (if alumni is legal guardian).
- Applications must be received by March 1, 2025 for consideration for Spring 2025.
