AAUW NAPERVILLE AREA (IL) CRITERIA FOR THE 2023 SUE TOPP INSPIRATIONAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

Age Requirement: Applicants must be female or non-binary presenting persons of any age.

<u>Undergraduate Degree Program</u>: Only students enrolled part-time or full-time in either an associate's degree or bachelor's degree program (including accelerated programs) at an accredited institution will be considered.

<u>Graduation Timeline</u>: Candidates must either: (a) be on track to graduate by December 31, 2023, if enrolled in an associate's degree program; or (b) achieve junior status by March 31, 2023, if enrolled in a bachelor's degree program.

<u>Academic Scholarship</u>: Because this is a scholarship and not a grant, the required cumulative GPA is 3.0. **Official transcripts are required of all finalists**.

<u>Financial Considerations</u>: The financial need of applicants will be considered. However, this does not necessarily mean that financial need will take precedence over scholarship. All criteria will be considered for each applicant.

<u>Residency Considerations</u>: The scholarship is available to those who reside in or attend school in DuPage, Will, Kendall or Kane Counties in Illinois.

<u>Quality of Written Personal Statement</u>: We are looking for applicants who demonstrate excellent writing skills and can delineate clear academic and life goals, including how their leadership skills have already and will continue to apply. We are also looking for detailed explanations of financial need.

<u>Quality of Interview</u>: From the entire field of applicants, the most qualified finalists will be chosen to interview with the scholarship committee. We will be looking for articulate responses to our questions, especially regarding the applicant's past and current leadership positions, the leadership qualities they have acquired, and how they hope to apply these qualities in their future career and within the community at large. We hope that the person chosen to receive the scholarship will consent to have AAUW Naperville Area follow up with her after the scholarship funds have been expended.

<u>Future Goals</u>: During the interview process, we would also like to hear about how the scholarship finalists intend to use their education and leadership abilities to make meaningful contributions to society, both now and in the future.

<u>Submission of Application and Transcripts</u>: The completed application, including the applicant's personal statement and financial statements, must be submitted by regular mail to the address specified in the application. **Deadline extended! Applications must be received by March 31, 2023.** If selected as a finalist, official transcripts will also be required. Upon request, transcripts must be submitted in the manner set forth in the application.

<u>Publicity</u>: The scholarship recipient must consent to allow AAUW Naperville Area (IL) to use her name, likeness and general information, such as school, field of study and goals, for publicity purposes and must also be able to attend our annual awards brunch on May 13, 2023.

Describe any leadership positions you currently hold or have held, either in school or in your community, the leadership qualities you have acquired as a result, and how you hope to use your leadership abilities to make a meaningful contribution within your career and to society, both now and in the future. Also, if you have supported the advancement of gender equity for women and girls in school or within the community, please tell us how. The more you tell us about yourself, the more fairly we can award this scholarship. The essay should be a minimum of 550 words. Use additional paper and attach.

2. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FROM YOUR SCHOOL

Please enclose a copy of your financial statement from your school. This should include information on your financial aid package, any grants you have received and your current bill. Usually, all this information is in the same statement. The financial statements may be unofficial photocopies.

3. **OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS**

If selected as a finalist, one copy of your official transcripts from your current institution must be provided. The transcripts must be in a sealed envelope stamped by your institution on the back. If you transferred to your current institution, we do NOT need copies of your transcripts from your previous institution if the transfer credits are reflected on your current transcript. If your institution will not release official sealed transcripts to you, please have them sent separately to our address.
