Questions Received:

1. On page 6 under Performance Bond it states the requirement for a A-XIV best rating, the attorney from our bonding company says our surety company has a rating of A-VII best- is this rating acceptable to bid the project?
The rating listed in the bid documents must be followed.
2. Where can I find the performance specifications for the synthetic turf product that is to be bid- I cannot find these specifications in the Bid Package.
Synthetic turf specifications are included in bid addendum #1.
3. For the permanent portion of the turf installation, will that area be a total glue-down or just a seam and perimeter glue-down?
Total glue down is required.
4. Turf lines are mentioned on the specifications but are not included on the diagram. Could you please include both the diagram for the lines and specify if they are to be in-lain into the turf or painted on?
There are no lines needed for the turf.
5. Regarding playing lines: no lines are included the specifications. If there are to be playing lines, are they to be painted on or in-laid into the turf?

6. Turf lines are mentioned on the specifications but are not included on the diagram. Could you please include both the diagram for the lines and specify if they are to be in-lain into the turf or painted on?
See the response to question #4.

7. For the permanent portion of the turf installation, will the permanent portion be TOTALLY GLUED DOWN TO THE CONCRETE, or will it be SEAM AND PERIMETER GLUED TO THE CONCRETE?

8. Are there Playing lines? No playing lines shown on drawings.
