

TEAS Testing at the Joliet Junior College Testing Center: Interpretation Guide

How can I retrieve my scores?

- After the test is completed, your results will be available within a few hours. You may access them on the “My Results” page found in your personal ATI student account online.

How often can I retest?

- The TEAS exam may be taken no more than 3 times in a 5 year period, and only one time per semester (Spring, Summer, and Fall).

Who should I speak with about whether I should retest?

- All programmatic and retesting questions should be directed to your program advisor. Below is a list of programmatic contact information for Nursing, Radiologic Technology, and Diagnostic Medical Sonography.
