TEAS Testing at the Joliet Junior College Testing Center: Interpretation Guide

Common Questions and Answers

How can I retrieve my scores?

After the test is completed, your results will be available within a few hours. You may access them on the "My Results" page found in your personal ATI student account online.

How often can I retest?

With the new version of the TEAS (7) in June of 2022, the counter will be reset. Students who had taken TEAS (6) 3-times will now be able to take TEAS (7) 3-times in 5 years. Students should only take the TEAS test once per semester.

Who should I speak with about whether I should retest?
