TEAS Testing at the Joliet Junior College Testing Center: Interpretation Guide

How can I retrieve my scores?

• After the test is completed, your results will be available within a few hours. You may access them on the "My Results" page found in your personal ATI student account online.

How often can I retest?

- The TEAS exam may be taken no more than 3 times in a 5-year period, and only one time per semester (Spring, Summer, and Fall).
- With the new version of the TEAS (7) in June of 2022, the counter will be reset. Students who had taken TEAS (6) 3-times will now be able to take TEAS (7) 3-times in 5 years. Only the first score of any semester is valid for ranking in our programs. All other attempts in a semester are counted against your total allowed attempts in 5 years.
