Guaranteed Admission Agreement

Take advantage of this Guaranteed Admission Agreement and easily transfer into one of Saint Xavier University's bachelors degree programs. JJC students can transfer up to 80 credits into Saint Xavier University.

About the Agreement:

1. Eligible to students who have completed a qualifying Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Associate in Fine Arts, Approved Associate in Applied Science, or Certificate.
2. Applicants successfully completing a qualifying degrees or certificate who have not subsequently matriculated at any other institution of higher education will be guaranteed transfer admission to SXU for most programs. Additional requirements with higher grade point average criteria may apply on selective admissions programs (e.g. Communication Science Disorders, Education, and RN-BSN).
3. Students who achieve a transferrable GPA of 3.75 on a 4.0 scale will have a guaranteed invitation to apply to the Honors Program at SXU. Additional application materials are required to be admitted into the Honors Program.
4. Students transferring from JJC to SXU who meet application deadlines, academic and financial qualification that apply to all students, may be eligible for consideration for scholarships offered by SXU.
5. Students should work closely with their advisor at JJC to develop an academic plan to ensure a seamless transition.

Notes:

1. All courses meeting gen ed requirements at JJC will transfer and be applied toward degree requirements at SXU
2. Upon matriculation to SXU, JJC students must satisfy all general education, graduation, and major requirements as outlined in the specific Transfer Guides.
3. This agreement applies to all Saint Xavier programs with the exception of Nursing and Accelerated Nursing.

Additional Information:

Admission Criteria:

General admission criteria for most transfer programs:

A minimum cumulative college grade point average of 2.0 with at least two full-time college semesters attempted (or 30 hours).

Communication Sciences and Disorders:

A minimum 3.0 cumulative college grade point average with at least two full-time college semesters attempted (or 30 hours) is required.

Education:

A minimum 3.0 cumulative college grade point average with at least two full-time college semesters attempted (or 30 hours) is required for consideration for full admission to SXU's

Transfer Student Scholarships:

*Transfer Admission Scholarships**: All incoming transfer students who intend to enroll at SXU full-time will receive a transfer admission scholarship (either a Transfer Merit Scholarship or Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship) based on cumulative college grade point average or PTK membership. Students are also eligible for the Preferred Partner Scholarship in addition to Transfer Student Scholarship.

About SXU:

Saint Xavier University (pronounced **ZAY-vier**) was founded in Chicago by the Sisters of Mercy in 1846, holding the distinctions of being Chicago's first Catholic university as well as the first Mercy institution of higher learning in the world. Initially serving as a higher education institution for women and the poor, today the four-year, private Catholic institution serves a diverse population of persons who seek a Mercy education that prepares them to become successful, productive and compassionate members of society.
