



High School Transcripts & Transition MATH

For students who receive portability, high school transcripts must list 3 pieces of information inline or in the notes:

- Portability Code
 - TM001 for STEM Pathway
 - TM002 for QL/Stats Pathway
- End Date of Course
 - the last day of the academic year
- Grade for **BOTH** semesters

EXAMPLES:

IMPORTANT CHANGES!

Beginning Fall 2024, a student must earn a grade of C or better **BOTH** semesters to get portability.

Grade is no longer cumulative.

Only stamp a portability code if a student earned a C or better **BOTH** semesters.

Please remember, all portability codes expire after 18 months.
